

MATCH FIVE

LEVEL: K-4

SKILLS: Short Vowels

EQUIPMENT: Red vowel cards, vowel dice

GOAL: Be the player with the most red vowel cards once the deck has been depleted.

TO PLAY:

- Each player gets five red vowel cards face up.
- Player one rolls their vowel die and looks at their first vowel card to see if they can use it to form a word. If they can, they place that card in their "keep" pile and go on to their next card. If they're unable to form a word, the card should remain in place, and they can look at the next card, until they've gone through all five. The player should make sure to leave their vowel die as rolled, as it will be used again.
- Player two takes their turn.
- Each player now has the chance to "steal" any of their opponents unused vowel cards, if they can use their vowel die (as already rolled) to complete a word.
- To play another round, just deal five more vowel cards and re-roll your die.
