WORD RACE

LEVEL: K+

SKILLS: Creating 3-letter words, ending sounds, middle sounds

EQUIPMENT: Letter die, Word Race game board, letter tiles

(optional)

GOAL: To make words by combining a rolled letter with a phonogram

NOTE: It can be helpful to review the letter die with your students. Which are vowels which are consonants (hint: they are different colours on the die). Also note that some letters are underlined to avoid confusion with other letters.

TO PLAY:

- (Var. 1) Pick a phonogram family from the suggested list. (e.g., "et"). Roll the letter die and ask: can you create a word using the letter rolled and the phonogram (e.g., 'get' or 'met')?
- Players take turns rolling the letter die until they can combine their letter with the phonogram to create a word. Write the completed words in a frame on the word race board.
- (Var. 2) Pre-fill the game board with a selection of phonograms
- Players take turns rolling the letter die until they can combine their letter with any of the phonograms on their board to create a word.

PRO TIP #1: Students may use blends. If the phonogram is 'ack' and they roll an 's', they can complete the word as 'stack' or 'snack'.

PRO TIP #2: Play competitively or cooperatively. If you're playing together your goal might be to fill the board. If you're playing competitively, each player might have to fill a column or row. Try writing your words in different colours and see who has the most when all the frames are filled.
